Position Vacancy - Kitchen Hand - Casual A vacancy currently exists for the role of Kitchen Hand at the Quairading Farmer's Co-operative's Commercial kitchen located within FoodWorks in Heal Street, Quairading, Western Australia, 6383. The position is available for an immediate start and/or a negotiated time convenient for both parties. Training opportunities will be provided onsite and online in order to gain appropriate certificates, namely "Food Handling Safety in a Retail Environment". Prior experience in food handling such as the cooking of meals and desserts, preparation of sandwiches and catering is preferred but not essential. Juniors are also welcome to apply. The hours of employment will be from Monday to Thursday from 7am to 2pm. The successful applicant will be employed under the Retail Award.
