BEFORE YOU BURN – CALL DFES

With the implementation of the Emergency WA app, all large burns within the Shire of Quairading must now be reported to DFES prior to commencement. Please notify DFES on 1800 198 140 or 9395 9209 at least 15 minutes before starting any burn larger than a small pile or campfire. Providing this information helps the DFES Communications Centre (COMCEN) distinguish between planned burns and potential emergencies when responding to Triple Zero (000) calls. Planned burns will also be displayed on the Emergency WA app, allowing residents to stay informed about activity in their area. The Shire strongly encourages all residents to download and use the Emergency WA app, which serves as the community's central and

reliable source of emergency information.

PROPOSAL TO DISPOSE OF LAND

In accordance with Section 3.58(3) of the Local Government Act 1995, the Shire of Quairading hereby gives public notice of its proposal to dispose of the following properties by way of freehold sale: 15 Reid Street, Quairading, proposed to be sold to Bentnail Building Pty Ltd for a consideration of \$10,000 (market valuation \$32,000); 21 Reid Street, Quairading, proposed to be sold to Daniel Hughes for a consideration of \$10,000 (market valuation \$33,000); and 6 Hinkley Way, Quairading, proposed to be sold to GW Trust for a consideration of \$38,500 (market valuation \$90,000). 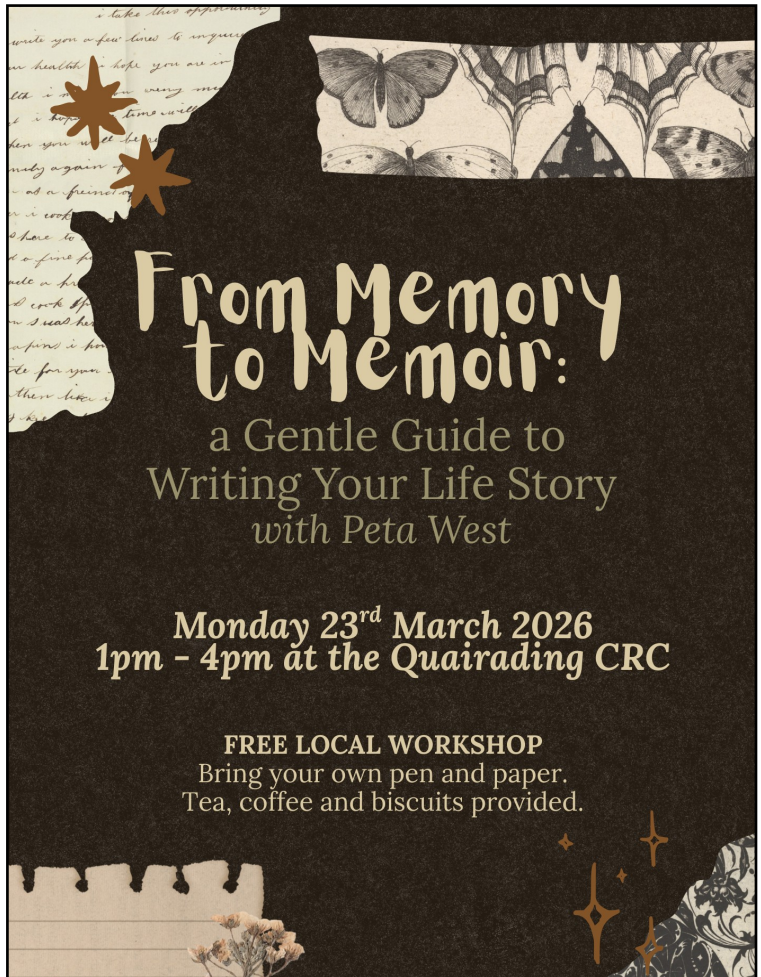
