WESTERN POWER

As part of our ongoing commitment to enhancing the network and improving your power reliability our crews will soon begin essential work in Quairading and surrounding areas. These works were originally scheduled to run from January to June 2025 and required a series of planned outages. However, due to unforeseen weather conditions and other important work in the area, planned works will commence in May 2025 and continue to August 2025. To complete these works safely, a number of planned outages will be required. You'll receive an outage notification in advance. (This timeline is subject to change for network emergencies, weather conditions, unplanned faults, or other technical reasons.). The scope of work is focused on strengthening the local network and includes: 55 pole replacements, 2.1 km of high-voltage conductor, 1.9 km aerial bundle cable (ABC) and equipment replacements, including transformers, crossarms, insulators, and reclosers. By reinforcing network infrastructure and enhancing resilience to weather events, this package of work will help ensure a more reliable supply for homes and businesses in the area. Impacted residents and businesses will be notified by Western Power up to 10 business days prior to each planned outage. Please check your notification carefully. 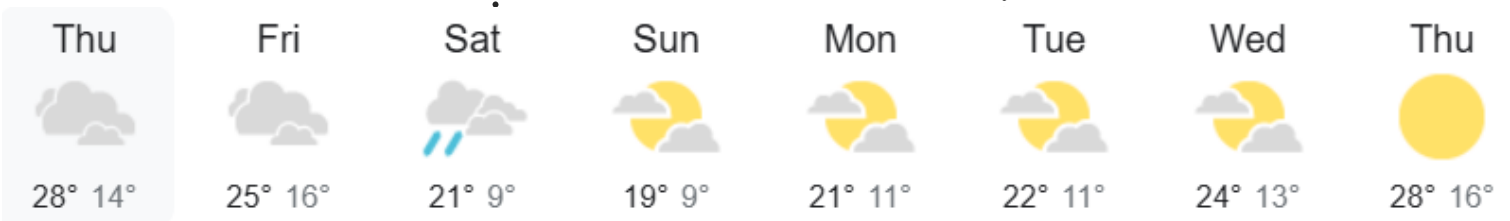
